Master-Renovation former Palais Palffy

Master-Renovation former Palais Palffy
Next to the Underground station (U3 station Herrengasse) there is this nearly inconspicuous building. The OSCE (Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe) became a new home in this former Palais. By order of the Federal Ministry of Economics and Labour, substituted by Burghauptmannschaft Österreich (Office of the Imperial Hofburg Vienna), the former Palais Palffy fulfilled a rebirth, designed by Ablinger, Vedral & Partner.

Old buildings mutate sometimes into useless labyrinths through history. When the people have left, the pigeons take over. If the client is not committed, the building is doomed to dilapidation. Once the future use of the building is defined and the people who are supposed to use it are determined, good orientation and daylight become the main theme of the renovation. Renovation has something to do with healing, healing with regeneration. A well done renovation revives the building, respects the existant, intervenes only to eliminate structural weaknesses and gives the building a new radiance. The valuable fabric of building was kept and restored, the less valuable,

aborted to let in more air and sunlight to the building.

As one result of the renovation of the former Palais Palffy, the great courtyard now is surrounded by a new Glass facade. The rooms located with view towards the courtyard were mainly offices. On the ground floor the cafeteria was planned with a wooden patio above water. The look of the courtyard works as a contrast to the new hightech facade. The patio, the water, the stones and the arranged plants were built on the same level. The relaxing sound of the water and the white grit function as a contrast to the dark glass facade. We design sustainable projects, from the first idea, to the complete house, from furniture to large scale projects. We believe that

구 웰피공의 리모델링

구 웰피공은 지하역사로 U3 해면기차역 옆에 사람들의 시선에서 벗어난 건물이다. 이 건물은 구 웰피공으로 현재는 비엔나에 위치한 호프부르크 왕궁이며 경제노동부 연방청의 명명 때 유럽안보협력회의의 본부가 되었다. 오래된 건물들은 시간이 지남에 불멸의 미로 되고 사람들이 떠나면 비움기들이 그 자리를 차지한다. 사람들의 노력이 없지 않으면 건물은 쓰임과 이용객들이 생애되면 좋은 방향과 빛이 리모델링하는데 있어 의미가 된다. 리모델링은 재생산을 수반하는 치유와 관계한다. 우리는 리모델링을 건물을 되살리고 기존의 것들을 유지시키고, 구조적 취약점의 제거 및 건물에 새로운 리모델링을 한다. 이는 건물의 구성을 유지, 회복시키고 리모델링되지 않은 요소들은 더 많은 빛과 햇빛을 건물 안으로 유입시켜 흡수되도록 하였다. 이전처럼 낮은 안마당을 전면이 에워쌌다. 식물들은 안마당을 향하도록 하여 주로 사무실로 사용되고 지층에 있는 카페는 옥상 파티오로 설계하였다. 안마당은 하이테크적인 새로운 파사드와 대조를 이루고 오, 물, 흙, 식물들은 모두 같은 고도로 설계되었다. 그리고 평온한 물소리, 허무한 유리 드와 대비되는 관적지갈과 초안부터 완성된 집, 거구에서부터 대규모 프로젝트까지 저하도록 설계하였다. 우리는 프로젝트에 집중할 때 좋은 결과가 나온다고 생각하여 마스크지와 건축기는 모든 프로젝트와 관련된 문제들을 초월하여 노력한다. 우리는 개인이나 리모델링으로부터 복제거국, 도시적계 등 모든 미학적인 사항들이지 재설계하여
